These stories have definitely been a favourite for the Ducklings. We have practised our new sound of the week 'C', learning the action song for it.

Next week:

Topic - Road Safety

Communication and language - We will be learning the importance of keeping safe on the road and different ways we can keep safe when crossing the road. We will also learn the names of some road signs, so we know what they mean when we walk along the streets. We will also be learning a new phrase 'Stop, Look and Listen!' - which we will chant before crossing the road.

Gross motor - We will be creating our own real-life road with potential hazards: toy cars, scooters, zebra crossing, pedestrian zones; the children will use everything we have learnt throughout the week to role play how to keep ourselves safe.

Fine motor - We will trace the sound of the week letter, our names and road shapes. We will also continue to practise using scissors, cutting out different road signs.

Art - We will create our own stop and go signs using lollipop sticks. We will also create our own traffic lights and cars!

Snack - bananas, satsumas, carrots, apples.
