This week, we continued our topic of "Wonderful Space". The children created lovely moons and suns to help them develop a better understanding of day and night. They also painted their own planets for their art books and talked about what made their planet special and why they chose it.

All of our activities were linked to our large selection of space-themed books, which helped to deepen the children's interest and understanding of the topic.

The Ducklings especially enjoyed singing the song "Zoom, Zoom, Zoom", which brought lots of excitement and enthusiasm to our learning about space.

### Next week:

**Topic** - Transport.

**Communication and language** - We will read *The Big Blue Train* and talk about different types of transport. The children will discuss how people travel from one place to another, including by car, train, bus, aeroplane and bicycle. They will be encouraged to share their own experiences of travelling with their families.

**Gross motor** - The children will use their imagination to fly like aeroplanes and drive like cars, helping to develop their coordination, balance, and movement skills.

**Fine motor** - We will practise cutting and tracing lines to help strengthen hand muscles and develop pencil control.

**Art** - The children will dip different transport toys into paint and make wheel prints, exploring the patterns made by the wheels.

**Snack** - melon, apples, peppers & cucumbers, broccoli, satsumas.
