## Next week:

<u>Literacy</u>: We will continue with our phonics; we will recap some things we introduced at the end of last term including our first tricky words. We will continue to differentiate our phonics depending on the children's various strengths, so individual Tapestry entries will give you a better idea about what they are each doing.

<u>Maths:</u> We will be looking at sequencing for the next two weeks including language such as "first, second, third" as well as linking this to our topics for sequencing events and time lines.

<u>Understanding of the World:</u> Our new topic (by popular demand) will be 'Dinosaurs', we will have an introduction week where we discuss all things Dino before zooming in on various aspects of Dinosaurs over the next few weeks.

<u>Arts and Crafts:</u> We will be looking at colour mixing, discussing what happens when various colours are mixed, and using the correct language for primary and secondary colours.

<u>Snack:</u> raisins & ricecakes, apples, peppers & cucumbers, broccoli.

## Other:
