Another busy week for the Ducks: the children have enjoyed dinosaur races, dinosaur parades and footprint painting. Through these activities, we have been learning to use ordinal numbers and we will continue to reinforce this next week.

The children were all very sensible during the school photos and were complimented by the photographer about their behaviour. We look forward to seeing the results! At Forest School, the children loved running around, creating magic wands with pipe cleaners and sticks, adding things they found in the woods before using them to cast spells on each other!

## Next week:

<u>Literacy</u>: Next week we will use our writing skills to annotate dinosaur stories and drawings and our phonics knowledge to sound out various words, as well as recounting our own individual stories to be scribed by us.

<u>Maths</u>: We will continue to discuss ordinal numbers to consolidate this knowledge. We will also be introducing the idea of 'time', looking at clocks and beginning to discuss how we tell the time.

<u>Understanding of the World</u>: Our dinosaur topic continues and we will be working with the children to create a dinosaur timeline, plotting our favourite dinosaurs on it and looking at how the environment changed along with the dinosaurs.

<u>Arts and Crafts</u>: We will be producing our new piece of art for our art book, looking at Basquiat's famous Dinosaur painting, producing a mixed media image.
